Lesson #2 —Crossing Jordan Scripture Text: Joshua 3-4

Introduction:

- 1. The conquest of Canaan has been a long time in coming. Israel is now here and ready for the Promised Land!
- 2. It is important to remember the victories of the past as we face the battles of the future.
- 3. In this lesson we will examine the crossing the Jordan and the memorial stones

I. PARTING THE JORDAN

- A. INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN
 - 1. They were to have a space between them and the Ark of the Covenant of 2000 cubits
 - a. 3.000 ft.
 - b. Little over ½ mile or 10 football fields
 - 2. They were to sanctify themselves -Possible reference to Exodus 19:10-14
 - 3. The priest were to set foot in the water first
- B. PURPOSE
 - 1. Exalt Joshua in the eyes of the people -vs. 7
 - 2. Prove that God was with them and would drive out their enemies -vs. 10

C. RESOLVE/RESULT

- 1. The Jordan overflowed its banks at the time of harvest
- 2. The waters were stopped at Adam -vs. 16

D. APPLICATION

- 1. God wants His people to believe in Him
- 2. He always provides proof

II. MEMORIAL STONES -Ch. 4

- A. INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN
 - 1. One man per tribe was to remove a stone from the Jordan –vs. 2-3
 - 2. They were to build a memorial from these stones –vs. 4-7

B. PURPOSE

- 1. This was to remind them of God's power and presence with them.
- 2. This was also to teach future generations of the events that transpired here.

C. APPLICATION

- 1. Memorials remind us today (E.g. the Lord's Supper)
- 2. Memorials provide us a teaching tool for future generations (Children are always curious; we should be prepared to answer them)

Conclusion:

- 1. God is with His people today
- 2. He has given us everything needed throughout His word
