BIBLE BOWL -2016

Lesson #9 –Sword of Gideon Scripture Reading: Judges 6:1-6

Introduction:

- 1. There was trouble in Israel once again due to unfaithfulness to the Lord -6:1-10 (summarize)
- 2. Gideon accomplished greatness after placing his faith in God
- 3. In this lesson we will examine three ways the Lord motivated him to success.

I. HE WAS STRONGER THAN HE REALIZED -6:11-35

- A. THE ANGEL OF THE LORD APPEARS TO HIM
 - 1. Gideon is hiding from the Midianites
 - 2. The Angel of the Lord says to him, "the Lord is with you, you mighty man of valor!" -vs. 12
 - 3. He claims he is the weakest in all Israel -vs. 15
 - 4. Gideon requests a sign from the Angel of the Lord and receives –vs. 17-23

B. HE PERFORMED A MIGHTY TASK

- 1. The Lord instructs Gideon to tear down the altar of Baal and the wooden image -6:25-27
 - a. The wooden image was Ashtoreth
 - b. This image was to be used as fuel for the fire for the sacrifice to God
- 2. The destruction is discovered -6:28-32
 - a. The men of the city realize that Gideon had destroyed the images of Baal and Ashtoreth
 - b. Their desire is to kill him
 - c. His father saves him from death with reasoning, "Let Baal plead..." -6:32

II. GOD WAS WITH HIM

- A. THE SIGN OF THE FLEECE -6:36-40
 - 1. Gideon desired to know that God was with him
 - 2. He request two signs from God
 - a. The fleece to be drenched in dew while the ground was dry -6:37-38
 - b. The fleece to be dry while the ground was wet with dew -6:39-40

B. GIDEON'S VALIANT THREE HUNDRED MEN -7:1-8

- 1. Let the fearful return to their homes -7:1-3
 - a. The glory would go to God, not to man
 - b. There were twenty-two thousand returned and ten-thousand remained -vs. 3
- 2. Drinking habits -7:4-8
 - a. God had them go down to the water; afterward a decision would be made.
 - b. The Lord had said those who lap like a dog were dismissed; three-hundred remained.
 - c. God would save Israel by the three-hundred -7:7

III. VICTORY WAS HIS THROUGH THE LORD

- A. GOD GAVE HIM ENCOURAGEMENT TO SUCCEED
 - 1. He went down into the camp with Purah his servant
 - 2. He overheard a dream of one of the soldiers and was strengthened -7:13-14

B. GOD GAVE HIM THE VICTORY

- 1. The trumpets, lanterns, and torches -7:15-18
- 2. They attack; every sword turns against his companion -7:19-23
- 3. The men of Ephraim attacked the Midianites and captured Oreb and Zeeb -7:24-25

Conclusion:

- 1. The Israelites were delivered because of their faith and obedience in God.
- 2. The Israelites reverted back into sin when all was a peace once again -8:33-35
- 3. The challenge for us is to remain faithful to God in times of peace.
