SHINNING THROUGH THE DARKNESS

Lesson #1 –Letting our Light Shine Scripture Reading: Matthew 5:13-16

Introduction:

- 1. Darkness can never conceal the power of light –E.g. camp devotionals
 - a. During this time all flashlights are to be off
 - b. Any camper who turns on their flashlight are quickly seen
 - c. Our light as Christians can never be hidden, nor should it be!
- 2. When we let our light shine before others, we are at war with the powers of darkness.
- 3. How do we win this war against the darkness?
- 4. We win the war by...

I. LOOKING TO THE LIGHT OF OUR SAVIOR

- A. HE IS THE LIGHT THAT HAS COME INTO THE WORLD
 - 1. John testifies of this Light
 - a. In Him is life and light that shines to all men -Jn 1:4-5
 - b. John came to testify of the Light, but was not the Light -Jn 1:6-9
 - 2. Jesus is the Light of the world –Jn 8:12
 - a. In context, a woman is brought before Jesus accused of adultery.
 - b. Through the Light of Christ, she found forgiveness among those desiring to condemn her.
 - c. Jesus instructed her to go her way and sin no more -Jn 8:11

B. HE WAS AT OPPOSITION WITH DARKNESS

- 1. He was tempted of the devil -Mt 4:1-11; Lk 4:1-13
 - a. Jesus was tempted in all points as we are, yet without sin -He 4:15
 - b. The devil only departed for a little while -Lk 4:13
- 2. He was rejected by men -Jn 1:11
 - a. Rejected by the religious elite
 - 1) They took pride in knowing the Law
 - 2) They should have known the prophecies about Christ -Ge 49:10, Ps 22, Is 53
 - b. Rejected by His followers –Jn 6:66-69
 - c. Rejected by His close disciples
 - 1) Peter denied the Lord three times –Mt 26:69-75, Mk 14:66-72, Lk 22:54-62, Jn 18:13-18, 25-27
 - 2) Judas betrayed Him –Mt 26:47-56, Mk 14:43-52, Lk 22:47-53, Jn 18:1-11
 - 3) All forsook Christ -Mk 14:50

C. HE DELIVERED US FROM THE POWER OF DARKNESS THROUGH THE GOSPEL

- 1. The gospel shined upon our hearts -2Co 4:1-7
 - a. God called the light to shine out of the darkness in the OT -Ge 1:3
 - b. Jesus shinned the light upon us today
 - 1) The light of Jesus reveals truth -Jn 14:6
 - 2) We can know the truth through Him –Jn 8:31-32
- 2. The gospel delivers man still today from darkness unto the light
 - a. The apostle Paul was sent out for this purpose –Ac 26:17-18
 - b. We have been delivered from darkness -Co 1:13, 1Pe 2:9
 - c. Therefore we must walk as "children of light" -Ep 5:8
 - d. If we do not walk in light, we do not have fellowship with God -1Jn 1:5-7

II. REFLECTING THE LIGHT OF OUR SAVIOR

- A. DOING GOOD WORKS
 - 1. We are following the example of Jesus -Ac 10:38
 - a. He was often moved with compassion for the multitudes -Mt 9:36
 - b. He would heal and teach them -Mt 9:35
 - 2. We are the "salt" and the "light" of the world -Mt 5:13-16
 - a. We are to be the agents of influence upon the world
 - b. We reveal the truth of God's word through the light we shine
 - 3. The purpose is to glorify God and not ourselves –Mt 6:1-18
 - a. Jesus teaches the proper attitudes in giving, prayer, and fasting
 - b. All we do is to glorify God -1Co 6:20

B. WE ARE TO SHINE THE LIGHT BEFORE MEN

- 1. Some despise the light
 - a. Jesus warned about this -Jn 3:19-21
 - b. We are not to have fellowship with them, but expose them -Ep 5:11-14, Lk 8:17
 - c. We must preach to word regardless -2Ti 4:1-5
- 2. Others joyfully come into the light
 - a. The apostle Paul -Ac 9:1-ff
 - b. Apollos -Ac 18:24-28
 - c. The apostle Peter –Jn 21:15-19

Conclusion:

- 1. E.g. -The lighthouse
 - a. The lighthouse is there to provide light to sailors so the rocks along the shore can be seen.
 - b. One would think all would love the light, but not all do.
- 2. Application: We must continue to let our light shine for those who love the light even in the midst of those who don't.
