Lesson #4 –Jesus is our Head Scripture Reading: Mark 11:27-33

Introduction:

- 1. The leaders of the day questioned the authority of Christ.
- 2. We must submit to the authority of Jesus.
- 3. We submit to the authority of Jesus because of...

I. THE ORIGIN OF HIS AUTHORITY

- A. CAME FROM THE FATHER
 - 1. This is stated in the Great Commission -Mt 28:18
 - 2. God had made Him to be Head -Ep 1:22-23, Co 1:16-20
 - 3. He sat down at the right hand of God -He 1:3
 - 4. To the Son He says... -He 1:8-9, 2:7
- B. REASON WAS HIS OBEDIENCE
 - 1. He suffered for the sins of mankind -He 2:9
 - 2. Humility and suffering -Ph 2:5-11

II. THE SOURCE OF HIS AUTHORITY

- A. THE WORD OF GOD
 - 1. They are the commandments of the Lord -1Co 14:37
 - 2. The Bible is the inspired word of God -2Ti 3:16-17, He 4:12, Ep 6:17
 - 3. Jesus promised the Spirit -Jn 16:13
 - a. The Spirit would speak what He hears
 - b. He would not speak on His own authority
- B. OBEDIENCE TO THE WORD OF GOD
 - 1. To be the body of Christ, we must submit to the head -Lk 6:46, Mt 7:21-23
 - 2. Salvation is through obedience -He 5:8-9

III. REACTION TO HIS AUTHORITY

- A. ABOVE ALL OTHER AUTHORITIES
 - 1. E.g. –The higher law we follow
 - 2. My sheep know My voice -Jn 10:1-5
- B. PUTTING HIM FIRST IN ALL THINGS
 - 1. Our only creed is the Bible –De 4:2, Pr 30:6, Re 22:18-19
 - 2. Singing and making melody in our heart -Ep 5:19, Co 3:16
 - 3. Salvation = Faith (Jn 8:24), Repent (Lk 13:3, 5), Confess (Lk 12:8, 9; Ac 8:37), baptism (Mk 16:16), and faithfulness (Mt 10:22; Re 2:10)

Conclusion:

- 1. Jesus is our head that we must follow
- 2. Jesus is leading us home.
