I. THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF SIN

- A. GOD WILL PUNISH SIN
 - 1. Some say that He is too much of a loving God to punish sin -1Jn 4:8, Jn 3:16
 - 2. God is also a just God -He 2:2, Pr 7:11
 - 3. Remember Jesus took our punishment for sin that we should not live in it -Ro 6:11, 2Co 7:1

B. SOME EXAMPLES

- 1. Old Testament
 - a. Adam and Eve cast out of the Garden of Eden -Ge 3:22-24
 - b. Nadab and Abihu burnt from fire above -Ex 30:9, Le 10:1-3
- 2. New Testament
 - a. Ananias and Sapphira -Ac 5:1-11
 - b. Herod -Ac 12:20-24

II. PUNISHMENT OF HELL

- A. THE LOST WILL BE CONDEMNED
 - 1. Those unprepared –Mt 22:12-14
 - 2. Those who do not obey the gospel -2Th 1:8
 - 3. Those who do not believe -Mk 16:16, Jn 3:18, 8:24

B. HELL IS ETERNAL

- 1. Some believe souls will be burned up immediately in hell
- 2. Jesus taught it is eternal punishment -Mt 25:46

III. THE IMPORTANCE OF BIBLE STUDY

- A. SOME UNDERMINE BIBLE STUDY
 - 1. Hananiah tried to quench the word of God
 - 2. Man tried to silence the teaching of Jesus –Ac 3-5
 - 3. The word is unstoppable -2Ti 2:8-9, Ph 1:12-14

B. THE IMPORTANCE CANNOT BE DENIED

- 1. People perish for lack of knowledge -Ho 4:6
- 2. The word illuminates our path -Ps 119:105
- 3. The word keeps us from sin -Ps 119:11, Mt 4:11
