Lesson #6 –The Darkness of False Prophets Scripture Reading: 1Kings 18:17-19

Introduction:

- 1. When we let our light shine we sometimes will feel alone in the struggle.
- 2. With God we are never alone when we shine our light before the darkened hearts of the age.
- 3. When we let our light shine, we will...

I. WE CAN STAND AGAINST A WORLD OF EVIL -18:20-25

- A. HE STOOD AGAINST 450 PROPHETS OF BAAL
 - 1. He had challenges of overcome (depression -19:4-10)
 - 2. We may have challenges to overcome
- B. ELIJAH STOOD WITH CONFIDENCE IN HIS GOD
 - 1. He displayed great faith in God by starting the challenge
 - 2. We have challenges before us (God pushed out of our culture, homosexuality, abortion, etc.)

II. WE WILL NEVER STAND IN SHAME – 18:26-29

- A. THEY WERE IGNORED -vs. 26
 - 1. Baal was the alleged god of weather who was usually portrayed with a thunderbolt in hand.
 - 2. He could not prevent or change the drought.
 - 3. He could not respond to his followers
- B. THEY WERE MOCKED -vs. 27
 - 1. At noon Elijah mocks them.
 - 2. We taunt in our sports today.
- C. THEY WERE UNSUCCESSFUL -vs. 28-29
 - 1. They cried louder and cut themselves
 - 2. No one paid attention.

III. WE WILL SERVE A GOD WHO CANNOT BE CHALLENGED - 18:29-35

- A. BAAL FAILED TO IGNITE A DRY SACRIFICE -vs. 29
 - 1. Why employ an incompetent god?
 - 2. When we misplace our faith it becomes vain faith.
- B. FOR GOD, THIS WAS TOO EASY! -vs. 32-35
 - 1. Elijah drenched the sacrifice
 - 2. God is not challenged by our problems -Ge 18:14, Ep 3:20

IV. WE WILL SERVE A GOD WHO ALWAYS EXCEED EXPECTATION - 18:36-40

- A. GOD HEARS OUR PRAYERS -vs. 36-37
 - 1. We do not have to be and plead before He answers –Mt 6:8
 - 2. We must ask in faith -Ja 1:6-8
- B. GOD EXCELS THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENT -vs. 38
 - 1. The sacrifice was all that was required
 - 2. Behold the awesome power of God

- C. GOD PREVAILS OVER EVIL -vs. 39-40
 - 1. At last the people believed, but it was too late.
 - 2. Atheist and those refusing to follow God will see His power first hand –Ph 2:9-11
