WHAT WE BELIEVE ABOUT JESUS

Lesson #5 –Jesus is our King Scripture Reading: Revelation 20:4-6

Introduction:

- 1. Most believe Jesus is king, but His kingdom is yet to be established.
- 2. Jesus is reigning over His kingdom now!
- 3. Because this is true, what about...

I. THE NATURE OF THE KINGDOM

- A. NOT OF THE EARTH
 - 1. The people misunderstood –Mt 20:20, Ac 1:6
 - 2. Jesus resisted being an earthly king -Jn 6:15
 - 3. Jesus was very clear -Jn 18:33-38

B. WOULD COME IN THE DAYS OF THE ROMAN EMPIRE

- 1. According to the prophecy of Daniel -Da 2:44
- 2. The image representing the four kingdoms: Babylon, Medo-Persian, Greece, and Rome.
- 3. John the Baptist preached that the kingdom of God was at hand –Mt 3:1-2
- 4. The kingdom cannot be shaken -He 12:28

C. IT HAS ALREADY COME

- 1. The predictions of Jesus
 - a. Would come while most of His audience was still alive -Mk 9:1
 - b. Would come shortly after His ascension -Lk 24:49
- 2. The fulfillment –Ac 2:1-4
 - a. Jesus gave Peter the keys of the kingdom -Mt 16:16
 - b. Peter used the keys -Ac 2:38, 41
- 3. We are in the kingdom today -Co 1:13

II. THE THOUSAND YEAR REIGN -Re 20:4-6

- A. THERE IS GREAT FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE WITHIN REVELATION
 - 1. Consider some: "key to the bottomless pit", "great chain in his hand", and "1,000 years"
 - 2. In the midst of all the figurative language, one phrase is taken literally -vs. 4

B. NOTE WHAT IS NOT SAID

- 1. The Second Coming of Christ
- 2. Jesus reigning on earth
- 3. The resurrection of the body
 - a. The first resurrection is figurative -vs. 5-6
 - b. Jesus mentions only one in His teachings -Jn 5:28-29
- 4. We will reign with Him for a thousand years
 - a. Those who are said to be reigning with Christ are those beheaded -Re 20:4
 - b. Nothing is said about anyone else reigning with Him for the thousand years
- 5. Jesus will ever set foot on earth again
 - a. We will meet Him in the air -1Th 4:16-18
 - b. He could not be our High Priest on earth -He 7:14; Nu 16:40

Conclusion: It gives us great comfort to know that...

- 1. We are a part of the kingdom now
- 2. The mission of Christ did NOT fail
- 3. Jesus will reign over His kingdom to the very end -1Co 15:24-26
