Introduction:

- 1. Some believe in God, but that He has left us on our own in this life (the deist).

I. SPIRITUAL NOURISHMENT

- A. PAUL'S ANALOGY -Ep 5:28-33
 - 1. Men nourish their own bodies
 - 2. Husbands take care of their wives (needs and comforts)
 - 3. Jesus fills this role with His church

B. SOURCE OF NOURISHMENT

- 1. Word of God which gives us two key advantages:
 - a. Spiritual growth -1Pe 2:2
 - b. Spiritual discernment –He 5:12-14
- 2. His word gives us life -Jn 5:39, 6:68, 12:48

II. SPIRITUAL STRENGTH

- A. PAUL'S EXAMPLE -Ph 4:13
 - 1. Strength to testify to a Philippian jailor -Ac 16:28-34
 - 2. Strength to testify before King Agrippa -Ac 26:1-ff

B. JESUS GIVES US THE STRENGTH WE NEED TODAY

- 1. Strength from those who endured
 - a. The Hall of Faith -He 11:30-40
 - b. The example of Paul -2Co 1:8-11
- 2. Strength from one another -He 10:23-25

III. SPIRITUAL REFUGE

- A. THE AVENUE OF PRAYER
 - 1. We can cast our cares on God -1Pe 5:7
 - 2. Jesus often withdrew Himself to pray –Mk 1:35, Lk 5:16
 - 3. We should follow the same example -Mt 6:6

B. THE WAY OF ESCAPE -1Co 10:13

- 1. The devil is always working against us -1Pe 5:8
- 2. The devil is limited; he can be resisted –Ja 4:7
 - a. Resist with reasoning (consider your destiny) -Lam 1:9
 - b. Resist with Scripture -Mt 4:1-11
 - c. Resist with departure -Ge 39:12

- 1. Through Jesus we have received every spiritual blessing we need -2Pe 1:3
- 2. He gives us nourishment, strength, and refuge.
- 3. When we faithfully follow after Jesus, He will lead us home.
