Introduction:

- 1. Many in darkness are comfortable and distain the light that would challenge their ways.
- 2. We must let our light shine through the darkness of false peace.
- 3. We allow our light to shine by first knowing...

I. WHY MANY HEED THE DOCTRINE OF FALSE PEACE

- A. SOME DENY THE EXISTENCE OF GOD
 - 1. Many are striving to remove God from our culture today
 - 2. God continues to exist whether or not man believes in Him -Ro 1:20-23

B. SOME BELIEVE HE IS TOO LOVING TO CONDEMN

- 1. On one hand, God is love -1Jn 4:8, Jn 3:16, 15:13
- 2. God is also just and sin must be punished -Mt 7:21-23, 25:41-46

C. SOME HAVE A FALSE PERCEPTION OF HIS GRACE

- 1. Some believe that once a person becomes a Christian, he can do no wrong
- 2. God chastens those He loves -He 12:7-9
- 3. We continue to walk in the light as He is in the light -1Jn 1:5-7

After we identify the trouble, we then look to some strategies of letting our light shine before men.

II. HOW WE LET OUR LIGHT SHINE

- A. LIVING THE CHRISTIAN LIFE -Ph 1:21
 - 1. We must not allow the world to influence us, rather we are to be the influence -Mt 5:13-16
 - 2. We are the ones to set the example before others -1Ti 4:12

B. PREACH / TEACH THE TRUTH IN LOVE -Ep 4:15

- 1. This is to love the sinner and hate the sin
- 2. Some examples from Paul:
 - a. The Philippian jailor -Ac 16:28
 - b. The men of Athens -Ac 17:16

C. ENDURE TO THE VERY END

- 1. Paul's counsel to Timothy -2Ti 4:1-5
- 2. Paul's valedictory -2Ti 4:6-8

Conclusion:

- 1. Shinning the light before those living in false peace is not easy because they love the darkness -Jn 3:19-20
