DISCIPLESHIP OF CHRIST

Lesson #3 -Are You Ashamed of Jesus Scripture Reading: Mark 8:34-38

Introduction:

- 1. Examine what all is involved in being a disciple of Christ as previously discussed.
- 2. Christians must never be ashamed of Jesus under any and all circumstances.
- 3. We must not be ashamed of Jesus because...

I. HE IS COMING BACK AGAIN

- A. THERE ARE MANY WHO LIVE ONLY FOR THE HERE AND NOW
 - 1. Some believe in God with plans to obey Him later in life. That day may never come -Ja 4:14, 2Co 6:2
 - 2. Some disregard God completely
- B. EVERY KNEE WILL BOW -Ph 2:9-11
 - 1. For those who have obeyed Christ and lived without being ashamed of Him, it will be a joyous day!
 - 2. For others, it will be everlastingly too late.

II. PROCLAMATIONS TO CONSIDER

- A. I AM NOT ASHAMED OF THE WORDS OF JESUS
 - 1. He has the words of everlasting life -Jn 6:68
 - a. He is the way, truth, and life -Jn 14:6
 - b. He teaches there are two paths one can take -Mt 7:13, 14
 - c. He teaches how to ensure we are on the right path -Mt 7:21 (obedience to the will of the Father)
 - 2. The power is in the gospel -Ro 1:16
 - a. These are the words that teaches salvation
 - b. We therefore must not be ashamed of them.

B. I AM NOT ASHAMED TO LIVE RIGHTEOUSLY

- 1. It can be difficult to go against the grain of society.
- 2. History remembers the one who stood their ground, not the ones who followed the crowd
- 3. We live in such a way no one can speak evil about us -1Pe 3:16, Ti 2:8

C. I AM NOT ASHAMED TO SUFFER FOR JESUS

- 1. We look to the suffering of the first century Christians and see their persistence -1Pe 4:12, 13; 16
- 2. E.g. Paul -2Ti 1:8, 12
- 3. Today we may not suffer to the same degree as they did, but we do suffer in other ways.
- 4. Remaining steadfast can be accomplished by looking back to their example.

D. I AM NOT ASHAMED TO LIVE FAITFULLY TO THE END FOR JESUS

- 1. Paul was going to glorify God in his life and in his death -Ph 1:20, 21
- 2. While most will not die for Christ, let us all strive to die in Christ -Re 2:10

- 1. Why are we not ashamed of Jesus in all these various aspects?
- 2. We are not ashamed so that when our Lord returns, He will not be ashamed of us -Heb. 2:11; Mt 10:32-33
