Introduction:

1. The greatness of being a Christian is serving Jesus.
2. There are valuable lessons we learn from Luke 5:1-11
3. In this lesson we will examine three lessons we can glean from our text...

## **I. OBEDIENCE THROUGH FAITH**

### **A. PETER OBEYED THE LORD**

1. Commandments of the Lord often goes against human reasoning -E.g. Jericho / Naaman
2. God always keeps His part; man therefore must do his.

### **B. OUR OBEDIENCE LEADS TO CERTAINTY OF OUR SALVATION**

1. Salvation through the cross -1Co 1:18; 22-25
2. Baptism -Mk 16:16

## **II. NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE WITH GOD**

### **A. FAILURES OF THE PAST DOES NOT DICTATE THE FUTURE**

1. E.g. Abraham and Sarah -Ge 18:14
2. Jesus healed a demon possessed boy when His disciples could not -Mt 17:14-21

### **B. EVANGELISM**

1. We have had discouragement in times past
2. We plant and sometimes we water -1Co 3:6, 7
3. There is power in the word -Lk 8:11; Ro 1:16; He 4:12

## **III. REWARDS ARE MUCH MORE THAN EXPECTED**

### **A. PETER NEEDED HELP WITH THE GREAT CATCH!**

1. Jesus provided a great number of fish; the nets were breaking and the boats were sinking
2. With God there is always more than enough
  - a. Feeding of the 5,000 -12 baskets left over
  - b. Feeding of the 4,000 -7 baskets left over

### **B. HEAVEN WILL EXCEED EXPECTATION**

1. Jesus has gone to prepare a place for us -Jn 14:1-4
2. Note some of the descriptions of heaven -Re 21:1-4

1. We must obey God in simple trusting faith.
