## Introduction:

- 1. The greatness of being a Christian is serving Jesus.
- 2. There are valuable lessons we learn from Luke 5:1-11
- 3. In this lesson we will examine three lessons we can glean from our text...

## I. OBEDIENCE THROUGH FAITH

- A. PETER OBEYED THE LORD
  - 1. Commandments of the Lord often goes against human reasoning -E.g. Jericho / Naaman
  - 2. God always keeps His part; man therefore must do his.
- B. OUR OBEDIENCE LEADS TO CERTAINITY OF OUR SALVATION
  - 1. Salvation through the cross -1Co 1:18; 22-25
  - 2. Baptism -Mk 16:16

## II. NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE WITH GOD

- A. FAILURES OF THE PAST DOES NOT DICTATE THE FUTURE
  - 1. E.g. Abraham and Sarah -Ge 18:14
  - 2. Jesus healed a demon possessed boy when His disciples could not -Mt 17:14-21

#### B. EVANGELISM

- 1. We have had discouragement in times past
- 2. We plant and sometimes we water -1Co 3:6, 7
- 3. There is power in the word -Lk 8:11; Ro 1:16; He 4:12

## III. REWARDS ARE MUCH MORE THAN EXPECTED

- A. PETER NEEDED HELP WITH THE GREAT CATCH!
  - 1. Jesus provided a great number of fish; the nets were breaking and the boats were sinking
  - 2. With God there is always more than enough
    - a. Feeding of the 5,000 -12 baskets left over
    - b. Feeding of the 4,000 -7 baskets left over

## B. HEAVEN WILL EXCEED EXPECTATION

- 1. Jesus has gone to prepare a place for us -Jn 14:1-4
- 2. Note some of the descriptions of heaven -Re 21:1-4
