Lesson #1 -Our Prayer Life Scripture Reading: Mark 1:35-39

Introduction:

- 1. We go to the doctor for physical check-ups. It is also important to ensure that we are spiritually healthy.
- 2. If we are to be right with God, we must have and maintain a healthy prayer life unto God.
- 3. Prayer keeps us spiritually strong by...

I. BEING THANKFUL BEFORE HIM

- A. THANKFULNESS KEEPS US HUMBLE BEFORE GOD
 - 1. All our blessings come from God our Creator
 - a. The rich and the poor are the work of His hands -Job 34:19; Pr 22:2
 - b. The hearing ear and seeing eye He has made -Pr 20:12
 - 2. Our thankfulness acknowledges our dependence upon God -Lk 17:11-19
 - a. Ten lepers came to Jesus for a healing
 - b. Only one returned to give thanks; a foreigner -vs 15-19

B. THANKFULNESS REMINDS US THAT HE IS WITH US

- 1. It reminds us of obstacles overcome in the past
 - a. E.g. Caleb Nu 13:28; Jo 14:12
 - b. E.g. Jeremiah -Je 1:8; 20:11
- 2. It gives courage as we face new obstacles
 - a. Obstacles of temptation -1Co 10:13
 - b. Obstacles of our mission -Ac 4:23-31

II. CASTING OUR CARES ON GOD

- A. THE TROUBLE OF WORRY
 - 1. Worry is a universal disease
 - 2. The futility of worry
 - a. One cannot add a cubit to their stature by worry -Mt 6:27
 - b. One said that worry is like rocking in a rocking chair, it takes you back and forth but lead you nowhere
 - 3. Worry breeds faithlessness in God
 - a. The disciples in the boat were afraid -Mt 8:25, 26
 - b. Peter became afraid on the water -Mt 14:30, 31

B. THE SOLUTION IS PRAYER

- 1. Hezekiah brought his trouble before the Lord -Is 37:14-20
- 2. We must remember to pray and never lose heart -Lk 18:1; 1Th 5:17

III. PRAYING FOR ONE ANOTHER

- A. WE KNOW OTHERS ARE PRAYING FOR US
 - 1. Jesus prayed for Peter -LK 22:31
 - 2. Paul told the churches they were in his prayers -Ph 1:3, 4, 9; Co 1:3; 1Th 1:2; 2Th 1:3; 2Ti 1:3, 4

B. WE SEE THE RESULTS OF PRAYING FOR OTHERS

- 1. The church prayed for Peter while he was in prison -Ac 12:
- 2. Paul requested prayers that he may be able to speak boldly -Ep 6:18-20
