# HIS OWN DID NOT RECEIVE HIM

Scripture Reading: John 1:10-13

#### Introduction:

- 1. Everyone has a basic need to feel accepted. No one likes to be rejected by others.
- 2. His own people rejected Him as their King.
- 3. We must ensure we do not make the same mistake by taking heed their example...

## I. HE DID NOT FIT THEIR EXPECTATIONS

- A. THEY THOUGHT HE WOULD BE KING / CONQUORER
  - 1. They considered His miracles (i.e. His healings, feeding of the 5,000)
  - 2. Becoming an earthly king was not His plan –Jn 6:15, 66, 18:36
  - 3. He predicted His own suffering and death which did not mesh with their thinking -Mk 9:30

#### B. THE EXPECTATION OF MAN TODAY

- 1. Many believe the Christian life is easy (E.g. the Rocky Soil –Mt 13:
- 2. It takes the strength that Jesus supplies to remain steadfast in the Lord –Ac 4:29, 30

# II. HE SHOWED DISAPPROVAL OF THEIR LIFESTYLE

- A. HE TAUGHT THE TRUTH IN LOVE
  - 1. The healing on the Sabbath -Lk 13:10-17
  - 2. Tradition vs. the Law -Mt 15:1-ff

### B. HIS WORDS OFFEND SOME TODAY

- 1. Repentance of sins –Lk 13:3, 5
- 2. Homosexuality: Jesus defined what marriage is -Mt 19:4-6

# **III. THEY WERE ENVIOUS OF HIM**

- A. HIS MINISTRY
  - 1. They could not make Him stumble in His words
  - 2. He had multitudes that followed Him
  - 3. Pilate knew this was the reason He was brought to him -Mt 27:18, Mk 15:10

### **B. OUR MINISTRY**

- 1. Some would like to see us stumble today as Christians
- 2. We therefore, must live above reproach -1Pe 2:11, 12
