Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:4-10

Introduction:

- 1. There are many great benefits from being a Christian!
- 2. We enjoy God's richest blessing every day.

I. HIS DAILY CARE FOR US

- A. PHYSICAL NEEDS
 - 1. We do not have to worry as others do -Mt 6:25-34
 - 2. Consider some examples:
 - a. The apostle Paul -Ph 4:13-ff
 - b. King David -Ps 37:25

B. EMOTIONAL NEEDS

- 1. We have the avenue of prayer -1Pe 5:7; Ph 4:6, 7
- 2. We have great assurance
 - a. God never leaves us nor forsakes us -Mt 28:20; He 13:5
 - b. Elijah was not alone -1Ki 19:18
 - c. Paul was not alone -2Ti 4:16, 17

II. BLOOD OF JESUS

- A. HAS CLEANSED US OF OUR SINS
 - 1. Our sins are washed away in the blood of Christ and remembered no more -He 8:12; 9:13, 14
 - 2. E.g. Paul was a former persecutor turned proclaimer! -Ac 22:16; 2Co 5:17
- B. HIS BLOOD CONTINUES TO CLEANSE US -1Jn 1:5-7
 - 1. We must walk in the light as He is in the light
 - 2. E.g. –King David who fell and arose again

III. HOPE OF HEAVEN

- A. JESUS IS PREPARING A PLACE FOR US
 - 1. This gives us great comfort -1Th 4:18; Re 22:20
 - 2. This gives us a sober mind concerning our conduct of life -2Pe 3:10-13

B. PREPARED PLACE FOR A PREPARED PEOPLE

- 1. We have been sanctified -1Pe 2:9, 10
- 2. We have been added to the church -Ac 2:47
- 3. We have been added to the Book of Life -Re 21:27; Lk 10:17-20

- 2. Once done, a soul will find all spiritual blessings in Christ! –Ep 1:3
