WHY PREACH ON HELL?

Scripture Reading: Matthew 25:41-46

Introduction:

- 1. Some passages we want to hear, others we need to hear.
- 2. Hell is too real and eternity is too long; we therefore must preach on hell.
- 3. We must preach on hell because...

I. WE ARE COMMANDED TO WARN / TEACH

- A. Example of Ezekiel –Ez 3:16-ff
 - 1. God had made him the "watchman" over His people
 - 2. His duty was to warn the wicked and the righteous that had strayed
- B. Example of Noah –Ge 6-9
 - 1. He knew the flood was coming.
 - 2. He spent 120 years building the ark and warning the people -2Pe 2:5

II. JESUS WARNED THE PEOPLE

- A. The Rich man and Lazarus -Lk 16:19-ff
 - 1. He described a man who had everything, but would not help a man with nothing
 - 2. The roles are reversed in eternity. Note the description.
- B. Three teachings dealing with eternity –Mt 25
 - 1. The wise and foolish virgins
 - 2. The Talents
 - 3. The Judgment on the nations

III. THE DESCRIPTION OF HELL IS HORRIFIC

- A. THE PLACE ITSELF
 - 1. Outer darkness
 - 2. Weeping and gnashing of teeth
 - 3. Eternal fire
- B. The Presence
 - 1. God is not there
 - a. We can know some places here overrun by evil
 - b. God however, is still present. This is not true of hell.
 - 2. The devil and his angels are there

IV. THE GOOD NEWS

- A. We Preach on Hell Because
 - 1. One can never appreciate the fullness of God's grace without it
 - 2. One can never appreciate salvation if he does not understand what he is saved from
- B. There is a way to avoid hell
 - 1. This is only through Jesus -Jn 14:6; Ac 4:12
 - 2. Through obedience to His will Mt 13:9, Jn 8:24, Lk 13:3, Lk 12:8, Mk 16:16, Re 2:10

Conclusion:

- 1. The gospel message of Jesus is open to everyone –Re 3:20, Mt 11:28-30
- 2. There is no reason to doubt your salvation!
