ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Lesson #2 -First Gospel Sermon Scripture Reading: Acts 2:1-4

Introduction:

- 1. Jesus told His disciples to wait in Jerusalem until they received the promise -Ac 1:4-8
- 2. Peter preaches Jesus as both Lord and Christ.
- 3. Peter reveals Jesus as Christ to the people by reminding them of...

I. PROPHECY -Acts 2:14-21

- A. The men are not drunk -vs 13-15
 - 1. Their assumption is absurd as Peter points out
 - 2. The explanation is much deeper and richer in meaning than intoxication.
- B. The Prophecy of Joel -vs 16-21
 - 1. The Spirit of God would be poured out on all flesh -vs 16, 17
 - a. This had just taken place
 - b. The first century Christians had gifts of the Spirit
 - 2. Signs and wonders -vs 18-20
 - a. Describes the events surrounding the cross of Christ.
 - b. The Day of the Lord (The day He overcame sin and death)
 - 3. Whoever calls on the Lord will be saved -vs 21
 - a. Salvation is found only in the Lord
 - b. This verse should not be taken alone (Mk 16:16; Ac 2:38; Ro 6:3, 4)

II. WHAT THEY WITNESSED -Ac 2:22-28

- A. This crowd knew Jesus in the flesh -Jn 7:25-30
 - 1. Division over the Christ.
 - 2. Some reasoned, "Will the Christ do more than this man?" -Jn 7:31
 - 3. They knew Jesus; His teaching and power. Therefore they are without excuse.
- B. The crowd consented to His death
 - 1. They cried out, "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!"
 - 2. God raised Jesus up from the dead as David prophesied.

III. WHAT THEY NOW COULD SEE -Ac 2:29-36

- A. David is still in the tomb
 - 1. He did not prophecy about himself.
 - 2. His prophecy was foretelling Christ.
- B. The Proof
 - 1. Jesus ascended to heaven and poured out the Spirit which they now see and hear -vs 33
 - 2. David's prophecy fulfilled -vs 34, 35
 - 3. God has made Jesus both Lord and Christ!

IV. WHAT THEY SHOULD DO -Ac 2:37-39

- A. They were cut to the heart
- B. Repent and be baptized
 - 1. Both preceded salvation for them
 - 2. Both precede salvation for us today.

Conclusion:

- 1. About three-thousand souls were added to the body of Christ.
- 2. They continued in the apostles doctrine and fellowship
- 3. The Lord added to their number daily -Ac 2:47
