ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Lesson #10 -Salvation to the Gentiles Scripture Reading: Acts 11:15-18

Introduction:

- 1. The last lesson we looked at the door of salvation opened to the gentiles
- 2. We clearly see that salvation through Jesus is open for whosoever will.
- 3. Chapter eleven reveals this very fact is several ways

I. THROUGH THE POWER OF GOD -11:1-18

- A. Peter began by defending the grace of God
 - 1. He is questioned about eating with the gentiles
 - 2. He then relates the story of events between him and Cornelius
- B. God gave them the same gift
 - 1. They all spoke in tongues -Ac 10:46
 - 2. He asks, "Who was I to withstand God?" -Acts 11:17

II. EFFECTIVE PREACHING -11:19-26

- A. Preaching
 - 1. There were some who only preached to the Jews -11:19
 - 2. There were others who preached to the Hellenist
 - 3. The hand of the Lord was with them and many were added to their number.
- B. Encouragement
 - 1. Barnabas went and encouraged the preaching to the gentiles to continue -11:23
 - 2. The disciples were first call Christians at Antioch-11:26

III. THE BENEFITS PRODUCED -11:27-30

- A. The prophet Agabus predicts an upcoming famine
- B. The disciples were motivated to send relief to the disciples in Judea -11:29, 30
 - 1. The gentiles received from the Jews salvation for their souls
 - 2. It was a great honor to be able to give them physical support

Conclusion:

- 1. Sometimes there are famines to give Christians the opportunity to shine
- 2. When we shine and share the gospel with other, the kingdom of God grows and flourishes.
