ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Lesson #14 -Jerusalem Council

Scripture Reading: Acts 15:1-5

Introduction:

- 1. Conflict is a part of life. It is something to be dealt with, not ignored.
- 2. Some times the church has to deal with inward conflict.
- 3. In this lesson we will observe how the first century church dealt with conflict from within...

I. <u>CONFLICT -15:1-5</u>

A. CIRCUMCISION

- 1. Some believed that circumcision was necessary for salvation
- 2. Paul and Barnabas however, greatly disagreed and taught against it
- 3. In order to resolve the matter, they are sent to Jerusalem

B. GOING TO JERUSALEM

- 1. On route they describe the conversion of the Gentiles which creates joy among the brethren.
- 2. At Jerusalem they are well received by the apostles and the elders
- 3. The Pharisees who were now believers, held on to part of the Old Law of Moses

II. <u>COUNCIL -15:6-21</u>

- A. PETER'S ADDRESS -15:6-11
 - 1. He discusses Cornelius and his conversion
 - 2. God accepted them by giving them the same outpouring of the Spirit.
 - 3. It is not just to enforce on them what the Jews were unable to bear!
- B. PAUL AND BARNABAS -15:12
 - 1. They were sent among the Gentiles and converted many to the Lord
 - 2. They discussed all the many miracles God had performed on their behalf, thus showing God's approval for them.

C. JAMES -15:13-21

- 1. He quotes from Amos 9:11, 12 illustrating that the door open to the Gentiles was according to prophecy.
- 2. He defended the Gentiles against trouble borrowed from keeping the Law of Moses which was no longer in effect -Co 2:14; Mt 5:17
- 3. He only stated a few aspects that they should keep -see vs. 20

III. RESOLUTION -15:22-29

A. THE LETTER

- 1. All were pleased to send with Paul and Barnabas two choice men back to Antioch -vs. 22
- 2. The content of the letter:
 - a. Addressed the problem
 - b. They have sent choice men to report the council's decision on the matter.
 - c. This had approval from the Holy Spirit
 - d. It closes with some things to abstain from.

B. APPLICATION FOR US TODAY

- 1. During times of conflict, it is best to talk it out.
- 2. Remember that the word of God is our authority today.

Conclusion:

- 1. The church had problems, but they worked through them together
- 2. When the church works together today, there is nothing that cannot be accomplished!
