ACTS OF THE APOSTLES

Lesson #26 -Journey Through the Storm

Scripture Reading: Acts 27:9-12

Introduction:

- 1. Give a summery of 27:1-8
- 2. We learn from the example of Paul's journey through the storm.
- 3. In this lesson we will see that Paul gave several things to the others on board the ship.

I. <u>HE GAVE A WARNING -27:9-12</u>

A. HIS EXAMPLE

- 1. Paul warned that they should remain at Fair Havens -27:10
- 2. His warning was ignored
 - a. The centurion would not take the advice of a prisoner over the owner and the helmsman
 - b. The majority advised to set sail -27:12

B. APPLICATION FOR TODAY

- 1. We too must give warning to those in spiritual danger
- 2. It is blessed when the warning is heeded by sincere individuals seeking the truth
- 3. Sometimes the warning is ignored
 - a. Pride can get in the way (i.e. man thinks he knows best)
 - b. The majority moves often in the wrong direction -Mt 7:13, 14

II. <u>HE GAVE HOPE -27:21-26</u>

- A. HIS EXAMPLE
 - 1. Give a brief summery of verses 13-20
 - 2. His words of hope
 - a. He stated they should have listened to him in the first place
 - b. There would be no loss of life, but rather the ship would be destroyed
 - c. The assurance came from an angel of God
 - d. Paul was assured he would stand before Caesar -27:24; 23:11
 - e. The ship however, would run aground -vs. 26
- B. APPLICATION FOR TODAY
 - 1. We give the world hope that is only found in the gospel of Jesus Christ.
 - 2. When one is obedient to the gospel, they have a hope that goes beyond the grave.

III. HE GAVE ENCOURAGEMENT -27:33-38

A. HIS EXAMPLE

- 1. He encouraged them to eat after fourteen days without nourishment
- 2. The assurance they would live:
 - a. When death is hanging overhead, food isn't a priority
 - b. Eating gave them not only physical strength, but mental and spiritual hope also.

B. APPLICATION FOR TODAY

- 1. Our spiritual nourishment today
 - a. Bible reading -1Pe 2:2; He 5:12-14
 - b. Prayer -1Th 5:17; Ph 4:6, 7
 - c. Fellowship -Ac 2:42
- 2. Encouragement from fellowship
 - a. We are bombarded by the evil and pressures of this world.
 - b. When we come together we give and receive encouragement from one another

Conclusion:

- 1. God keeps His promises -i.e. they all survived the storm at sea.
- 2. He still keeps promises today!
 - a. Through Jesus Christ we have salvation for our souls -Ep 1:7
 - b. Through Jesus we can be confident both in life and in death -Ph 1:21; 2Ti 4:6-8
