Lesson #1 -Father, Forgive Them Scripture Reading: Luke 23:32-37

#### Introduction:

- 1. The cross reveals the great love God has for man.
- 2. This unusual statement from the cross teaches us a great lesson on forgiveness.
- 3. In this lesson we will examine 3 aspects of forgiveness...

## I. THE FORGIVING NATURE OF JESUS

- A. WHAT HE ENDURED
  - 1. The rulers and soldiers mocking Him -Lk 23:35-37
  - 2. The criminals were mocking Him -Mk 15:32

### **B. HIS FORGIVENESS**

- 1. No one crucified has a forgiving nature toward their executioners
- 2. It is the greatest demonstration of God's love -Ro 5:6-9; Jn 15:13

### II. THE FORGIVING NATURE WE MUST HAVE

- A. WE FORGIVE TO BE LIKE JESUS
  - 1. Steven displayed forgiveness -Ac 7:60
  - 2. We can have a forgiving attitude toward those not sorry

#### B. WE FORGIVE TO BE FORGIVEN

- 1. The teaching of Jesus -Mt 6:14, 15
- 2. The number of times is not relevant -Mt 18:21, 22; Lk 17:3, 4

### III. HOW WE CAN BE FORGIVEN

- A. THE CROWD AT THE CROSS
  - 1. The statement of Jesus did not forgive them
  - 2. They still had to repent on their own -Ac 2:37, 38

#### B. MAN TODAY

- 1. Man must repent and obey Jesus -Lk 13:3, Jn 14:15
- 2. The blood of Jesus cleanses us today -Ep 1:7

#### Conclusion:

- 1. Anyone who comes to Jesus can be forgiven -1Ti 1:12-16
- 2. The cross teaches us the great love of God and His power to forgive
