Lesson #5 -Do Not Love the World

Scripture Reading: 1John 2:15-17

Introduction:

- 1. E.g. Keeping one's eyes on the road.
- 2. We must not love the world, nor the things in the world
- 3. We do not love the world because of...

I. WHAT THE WORLD HAS

A. DEFINITIONS

- 1. Lust of the flesh
 - a. This would include sexual immorality
 - b. The satisfaction of any fleshly indulgence apart from God's will.
- 2. Lust of the eye
 - a. Pursuing happiness by what one sees
 - b. This is a focus on the temporal, not the eternal -2Co 4:16-18
- 3. Pride of life
 - a. Motivates on to "keep up with the Joneses"
 - b. Seeking one's own glory
- B. EXAMPLES:
 - 1. Eve -Ge 3:1-6
 - 2. Jesus -Mt 4:1-11

II. WHAT THE WORLD DOES NOT HAVE

- A. DISTINCTION TO BE MADE
 - 1. One cannot walk in two paths -Mt 7:13, 14
 - 2. One cannot walk after the flesh and the Spirit -Ga 5:16-ff
- B. THE LOVE OF THE FATHER IS NOT IN HIM
 - 1. We remember what God has done for us -Jn 3:16, Ro 5:6-9; 8:31-ff
 - 2. Sin loses its luster in the light of God's love!

III. THE WORLD IS PASSING AWAY

- A. TWO IMPORTANT TEMPS:
 - 1. Our life is temporal -Ja 4:14; Ro 13:11-14
 - 2. The world is temporal -2Pe 3:10-13

B. HE WHO DOES THE WILL OF GOD

- 1. Loving God -Jn 14:15
- 2. Knowing His will -Hos 4:6; Ac 17:11
- 3. Doing His will -Ja 1:22; Ro 2:13; Lk 6:46; Mt 7:21-23

Conclusion:

- 1. What do we focus upon? (World, or God?)
- 2. Two destinies:
 - a. The world will be destroyed along with those who follow
 - b. Those who do God's will abides forever!
