BOOK OF 1 JOHN

Lesson #6 -The Antichrist Scripture Reading: 1 John 2:18-23

Introduction:

- 1. Some swindle others out of money; others deceive spiritually.
- 2. We must not fall for the deceptions of the Antichrist.

I. THE IDENTITY OF THE ANTICHRIST

- A. THOSE WHO REJECT JESUS COMING IN THE FLESH
 - 1. Some who were among the disciples strayed -vs. 19
 - 2. They denied Jesus coming in the flesh -1Jn 4:2, 3

B. THOSE WHO REJECT JESUS AS CHRIST (vs. 22, 23)

- 1. The Gnostics claimed Jesus and Christ were two different people
 - a. They claim: Christ appeared to have flesh, but did not.
 - b. They claim: Christ descended on Jesus after His baptism and left Jesus before His suffering. (Note the sayings on the cross to disprove this)
- 2. The Gnostics denied both Father and Son
 - a. He became flesh and dwelt among us -Jn1:14
 - b. To deny Jesus is to deny the Father -Jn 13:20
- 3. Today, the Antichrist is anyone who rebels against biblical teaching.

II. DEFENSE AGAINST THE ANTICHRIST -vs. 24-27

A. DURING THE TIME OF WRITING

- 1. They were anointed with the Holy Spirit -vs. 20-21, 27
- 2. They had the gifts of the Spirit to know all things -vs. 20
- 3. Yet, they still needed encouragement to continue in the faith -vs. 26

B. OUR DAY

- 1. We do not have the gifts of the Spirit today.
- 2. We do however, have the complete word of God to guide us in all truth -He 4:12, Ep 6:17, Jude 3, 2 Timothy 3:16, 17
- 3. Today, we still need encouragement from one another to continue fighting the good fight of faith.

Conclusion:

- 1. Our solution for today; let the message heard from the beginning abide in you. -vs. 24
- 2. We are living in the last hour today -2Pe 3:8, 9. Therefore, we focus on the word of God and the path of righteousness set before us.
