Lesson #10 -The Outworking of Love Scripture Reading: 1 John 3:16-23

Introduction:

- 1. In our previous lesson we discussed some of the pitfalls of not having love.
- 2. There is great responsibility and reward that comes with loving the brethren.

I. RESPONSIBILITY TO LOVE THE BRETHREN

- A. FOLLOWING THE EXAMPLE OF JESUS -vs 16
 - 1. He laid His life down for us -Jn 10:11-13, 17-18
 - 2. We follow by laying our lives down for the brethren.
 - a. This can be literal
 - b. In context, we help one another with our resources

B. PUTTING LOVE INTO ACTION -vs 17, 18

- 1. According to one's means to help his brother or sister
- 2. He must not close his heart to him -Cf. Ja 2:14-ff
- 3. We must love in deed and in truth

II. REWARD OF SHOWING LOVE

- A. WE ARE OF THE TRUTH
 - 1. Our conscience is in tune with God's word
 - 2. When we show God's love to other, we have confidence before God

B. WE ARE OBEYING HIS COMMANDMENTS -vs 22-24

- 1. His two-fold commandment:
 - a. Believe in Jesus
 - b. Love one another
- 2. We receive what we ask according to His will -1Jn 5:14
- 3. We abide in Him-vs. 24

Conclusion:

- 1. When we love as we ought we have no fears mentioned in our former lesson.
 - a. Children of the devil
 - b. Imitating Cain
 - c. Being a murderer
- 2. Close with Psalms 133:1-3
