Lesson #13 -Abide in God

Scripture Reading: 1 John 4:12-16

Introduction:

- 1. Our spiritual shelter is in God.
- 2. We have a great desire to abide in God and He in us.
- 3. How do we know that God abides in us?

I. THROUGH OUR LOVE FOR ONE ANOTHER -Jn 13:34, 35

- A. We are to love one another as He has loved us.
 - 1. He laid His life down for us -Jn 15:13
 - 2. Likewise, lay our lives down for the brethren -1Jn 3:16-18
- B. It is by our love that others will know we are His
 - 1. They will see Jesus living in us -Ga 2:20; 2Co 3:18
 - 2. Through love others are won to Christ

II. THROUGH HIS SON HE SENT

- A. THE EYE-WITNESS ACCOUNT
 - 1. John, along with the other disciples, saw the Savior
 - 2. John wrote that we might have faith in Him -Jn 20:30, 31; 1Jn 5:13

B. WE MUST CONFESS JESUS AS THE SON OF GOD

- 1. Jesus commanded it -Mt 10:22, 23
- 2. Peter demonstrated it -Mt 16:13-ff
- 3. If we are ashamed of Jesus, He will be ashamed of us -Mk 8:38

III. THROUGH ABIDING IN HIS LOVE

- A. GOD IS LOVE
 - 1. He has loved man from the very beginning
 - 2. He wants man to have life -De 30:19, 20
 - 3. He sent us His Son that we might have life -Ro 5:6-8
- B. WE LOVE OTHERS
 - 1. This includes those who are lost in sin
 - a. Jesus ate with sinners and tax collectors -Mt 9:11-13
 - b. Jesus came to the home of Zacchaeus -Lk 19:1-10
 - 2. This includes our enemies -Mt 5:43, 44; Ro 12:18-21

Conclusion:

- 1. We cannot abide in God without sharing in His characteristics.
- 2. We must see the example of His love through His Son.
- 3. We must abide in His love by following His blessed example.
