# LIVING SACRIFICES

## Scripture Reading: Romans 12:1, 2

Introduction:

- 1. People want great results, but often are not willing to do what it takes to accomplish them.
- 2. We are to be living sacrifices before God.
- 3. To be a "living sacrifice" we must...

## I. <u>DIE UNTO SIN</u>

- A. WE CANNOT SERVE THE FLESH AND THE SPIRIT -Ga 5:16-ff
  - 1. The flesh is going towards destruction
  - 2. The Spirit leads to life

### B. THE OLD MAN IS PUT TO DEATH

- 1. We take up our cross and follow Jesus -Mk 8:34-38; Ga 2:20
- 2. The distinction of living -Co 3:5-17
- 3. True Repentance -Ro 6:1-ff (Death to sin)

## II. GIVE GOD OUR BEST

- A. PERFECT SACRIFICE
  - 1. Under the Old Law -Mal 1:7, 8; Ex 12:1
  - 2. Jesus was our perfect sacrifice -2Co 5:21, 1Pe 2:22, Jn 19:4
- B. APPLICATION FOR TODAY
  - 1. Give God our best worship -Jn 4:24; Ep 5:19; Co 3:16; He 13:15
  - 2. Give God our best daily
    - a. Our example -1Ti 4:12
    - b. All glory to Him -1Co 10:31
    - c. All by His authority -Co 3:17

#### III. KEEP FOCUS ON THE EXPECTATION

- A. SACRIFICE FOR SOMETHING GREATER
  - 1. Under the Old Law one would stay in God's favor -De 28:1-ff
  - 2. Rich Young Ruler would not sacrifice temporal for the eternal -Mt 19:16-22
  - 3. Paul sacrificed for what he had to gain in Christ -Ph 3:4-8

#### B. OUR EXPECTATION IS HEAVEN

- 1. Our body is but a tent -2Co 5:4; 2Pe 1:13
- 2. We are pilgrims passing through this life -1Pe 2:11
- 3. Our citizenship is in heaven -Ph 3:20

#### Conclusion:

- 1. Being a "living sacrifice" before our God is not always easy.
- 2. The benefits however, far out weigh all else -READ: Romans 8:18
