BOOK OF 1 JOHN

Lesson #16 -Certainty of Witness Scripture Reading: 1John 5:6-12

Introduction:

- 1. Last week, our faith overcomes the world.
- 2. Our faith is firmly grounded in Jesus as the Son of God through the witnesses.

I. THREE-FOLD WITNESS -vs. 6-8

A. SOME THEORIES

- 1. The water and blood from the side of Jesus
- 2. Baptism and the Lord's Supper
- 3. Purification and redemption
- 4. Water (Jesus' baptism) and blood (Jesus' death)

B. GNOSTIC TEACHING

- 1. They believed that Christ came upon Jesus at His baptism
- 2. They believed that Christ left Jesus just before His death
- 3. The teaching of John refutes their teaching

C. THE WITNESSES

- 1. The blood and the water prove that Jesus was God in the flesh throughout His time
- 2. The Spirit
 - a. Taught through the apostles -1Pe 1:12
 - b. Confirmed the word by signs -Ac 14:1, 2
 - c. He is the Spirit of Truth -Jn 14:17; 15:26; 1Jn 4:6

D. EXPLANATION OF VERSE 7

- 1. Found in the KJV, but omitted from many other versions
- 2. It is not found in any manuscripts earlier than the 14th century
- 3. Erasmus revised the Vulgate and left out verse 7
 - a. He was criticized for omitting it.
 - b. He said if the phrase could be found, he would include it.
 - c. It was found in a margin
 - d. He later included it in his third edition.

E. THREE MEMBERS OF THE GODHEAD

- 1. They are three in number -2Co 12:13
- 2. They are one in unity -De 6:4; Ge 1:26

II. TRUSTWORTHY WITNESSES -vs. 9, 10

- A. THE WITNESS OF MAN
 - 1. Under the old Law 2 or 3 were needed -De 17:6
 - 2. False witness testimony against Christ did not agree -Mk 14:56

B. THE WITNESS OF GOD

- 1. The water, blood, and Spirit are in perfect agreement
- 2. This makes their testimony absolutely trustworthy

III. BENEFIT OF THE WITNESS -vs. 11, 12

- A. WE HAVE ETERNAL LIFE THROUGH JESUS
 - 1. This is not our eternal home now
 - a. It is to come -Mk 10:29, 30
 - b. Hope of eternal life -Ti 1:2; 1Jn 2:25
 - c. We don't hope for what we have -Ro 8:24
 - 2. We can leave the faith -1Ti 5:12; 2Ti 2:16, 17
- B. OUR FAITH IN JESUS IS CONFIRMED THROUGH THE WITNESSES
- C. WE OVERCOME THE WORLD -1Jn 5:5

Conclusion:

- 1. Through the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus we have great hope
- 2. Through our faith in Him, we overcome the world!
