NO REGRETS

Scripture Reading: 2 Timothy 4:6-8

Introduction:

- 1. Paul could look back upon his life with no regrets.
 - a. He had events he was not proud of (i.e. persecuting the church, the death of Steven)
 - b. He had been cleansed by the blood of Jesus and therefore regret was gone.
- 2. We, like Paul, can look back upon our lives with no regrets.
- 3. We look back with no regrets when we...

I. FIGHT THE GOOD FIGHT OF FAITH

- A. ABLE TO ABSORB A PUNCH
 - 1. Paul was able when he was stoned and left for dead -Ac 14:19, 20
 - 2. We have trials and tribulation and must get back to our feet

B. ABLE TO DELIVER A PUNCH

- 1. This is able to defend the faith -Jude 3
- 2. Paul was able -Ac 17:1-ff

II. FINISH THE RACE

- A. THE TYPE OF RACE WE RUN
 - 1. It is no a 100 yd dash
 - 2. It is a marathon. We are in it for the long haul -Re 2:10

B. WE MUST COUNT THE COST

- 1. According to the words of Jesus -Lk 9:59-ff
- 2. Ananis told Paul the things he would suffer for Jesus; he preached fearlessly

III.KEEP THE FAITH

- A. NEVER COMPROMISE TRUTH
 - 1. Paul never reverted back, but pressed on -Ph 3:12
 - 2. Paul knew what he had to gain in Christ -Ph 3:8-ff

B. THE VALUE OF TRUTH

- 1. Buy truth and sell it not -Pr 23:23
- 2. The truth sets us free from sin -Jn 8:31-ff

- 1. We may have some regrets looking back.
- 2. However, when our sins have been washed by the blood of Jesus we have the greatest future
