# THE FEAR OF THE LORD

Scripture Reading: Exodus 20:18-21

Introduction:

- 1. There are many things one might fear (spiders, snakes, etc.)
- 2. The fear of the Lord promotes healthy spiritual growth.
- 3. How does the fear of the Lord accomplish this?
- 4. Three ways the fear of the Lord benefits us are...

### I. IT IS THE BEGINNING OF KNOWLEDGE

- A. WITHOUT FEAR, THERE IS NO RESTRAINT
  - 1. Without revelation, people cast off restraint -Pr 29:18
  - 2. The absence of fear is the beginning of all evil
    - a. E.g. -the days of the Judges -Ju 17:6; 21:25
    - b. Note the words of Paul -Ro 3:10-18
- B. PROPER FEAR GUIDES ONE TO RIGHTEOUSNESS
  - 1. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge -Pr 1:7
  - 2. The fear of the Lord keeps one on the narrow path
    - a. Two paths Jesus discussed -Mt 7:13, 14
    - b. The path of walking in the light -1Jn 1:7

### II. <u>IT HELPS US OVERCOME EVIL</u>

- A. BY DEPARTING FROM EVIL
  - 1. The consequences of evil
    - a. Wages of sin is death -Ro 6:23
    - b. Those who practice sin are condemned -Ga 5:19-21
  - 2. When one understands true fear -He 10:26-ff
    - a. Fearful judgment -vs. 27
    - b. Worse punishment -vs. 28
    - c. Falling into the hands of God -vs. 31
- B. BY HATING EVIL -Pr 8:12-14
  - 1. He who hate evil will abstain from pride -vs. 13
  - 2. He who hates evil will cling to knowledge and discretion
  - 3. He who hates evil will strive to be like Christ -Ep 5:1

## III. IT LEADS TO ABUNDANT LIVING -Pr 14:26, 27

- A. BY PROVIDING STRONG CONFIDENCE
  - 1. When one does, good there is nothing to fear
    - a. Obeying the laws of the land -Ro 13:3
    - b. As God told Cain -Ge 4:6, 7
  - 2. Christians should have great confidence before God
    - a. Confidence at His appearing -1Jn 2:28
    - b. Clean conscience -1Jn 3:21
    - c. Do not cast away your confidence -He 10:35
- B. BECAUSE IT IS A FOUNTAIN OF LIFE
  - 1. It turns one from the snare of death
  - 2. It points one in the direction of life

#### Conclusion:

- 1. Not all fear is bad.
- 2. The fear of the Lord leads us to eternal salvation in the Lord.
