BEHOLD, THE BRIDEGROOM IS COMING

Scripture Reading: Matthew 25:1-13

Introduction:

- 1. "One of the illusions of life is that the present hour is not the critical, decisive hour..." Ralph Emerson.
- 2. The most important activity to prepare for is eternity
- 3. How can we fully be prepared for eternity?
- 4. Jesus gives us four warnings to heed within this parable.

I. PLAN AHEAD

A. CONTRAST: WISE AND FOOLISH VIRGINS

- 1. They were invited and were present
- 2. They were alike in their knowledge and ignorance
- 3. The distinguishing difference was: five were prepared and fiver were not -vs. 3, 4

B. KNOW WHAT IS COMING

- 1. E.g. McCalls hill in Arkansas City, KS
- 2. The Lord will return to claim His own -1Th 4:16-18
- 3. Be prepared:
 - a. The Scriptures prepares us
 - b. The Bible is all we need -2Ti 3:16, 17

II. THE FAITH OF OTHERS WILL NOT SAVE US -vs 6-9

A. THE PROBLEM

- 1. The foolish virgin's lamps were going out
- 2. We often don't realize what is important until it's too late

B. THE ATTEMPTED SOLUTION

- 1. They tried to borrow from the prepared
- 2. One cannot borrow righteousness from others
- 3. Each must have his own righteousness before God.

III. LAST MINUTE REPENTANCE WILL FAIL

A. TIME IS OUR MOST PRECIOUS COMMODITY

- 1. We can waste money and recover.
- 2. This is not true of our time. Once it is gone, it is gone forever.

B. WE MUST REDEEM THE TIME -Ep 5:16; Is 55:6

C. THE LORD IS GOING TO RETURN -1Th 5:1-4

- 1. He will come as a "Thief in the night"
- 2. His return is as certain as labor pains on a pregnant woman

D. WE MUST NOT NEGLECT OUR SALVATION -He 2:1-3

- 1. We must give heed to what we have heard
- 2. Every transgression will be punished
- 3. We will not be able to escape if we neglect our salvation.

IV. WE CANNOT KNOW WHEN THE LORD WILL RETURN

A. SOME CLAIM TO KNOW

- 1. The tabloids are full of guesses
- 2. Jesus said that only the Father knows the day -Mt 24:36

B. OTHERS DENY THE RETURN OF THE LORD

- 1. He isn't coming back -2Pe 3:3-6
- 2. He is coming and the earth will be destroyed -2Pe 3:10, 11

Conclusion:

- 1. Remember that life is not forever, but eternity is.
- 2. Let us not neglect our salvation and be ready.
