JESUS - WHO WOULD NOT SAVE HIMSELF

Scripture Reading: Matthew 27:38-44

Introduction:

- 1. Jesus mocked while on the cross -Mt 27:38-44
 - a. He saved others, but not Himself
 - b. He was ridiculed for this
- We see in Jesus a Savior Who did not have to die, but laid down His life for us.
- -- In this lesson we will examine 2 key elements in the sacrifice Christ made on the cross for our sins --
- I. NO ONE COULD TAKE HIS LIFE Jn 10:17, 18
 - A. SOME HAD TRIED...
 - 1. Herod Mt 2:16
 - a. Had all the male babies 2yrs and younger killed.
 - b. He was unsuccessful at killing Christ before the time
 - 2. Citizens of Nazareth -Lk 4:28-30
 - a. They did not accept His teaching
 - b. They attempted to push Him off a cliff
 - c. Jesus just walked through their midst
 - B. WHEN DELIVERED OVER TO ROMAN AUTHORITY
 - 1. In the Garden Mt 26:52-54
 - a. Peter cuts off Malchus ear
 - b. Jesus could call more than 12 legions of angels
 - 1) One angel destroyed 185,000 -2Ki 19:35
 - 2) Legion consisted of 6,000 foot men & 600 horsemen in the days of Christ. 12 legions equals 79,200.
 - 2. Before Pilate -Jn 19:10, 11
 - a. Pilate thought he was in charge
 - b. Jesus adjusted his thinking.
 - C. ALL WAS DONE TO FULFILL PROPHECY
 - 1. To Nicodemus -Jn 3:14-17
 - 2. In the Garden Mt 26:55, 56
 - 3. Prophecy by Isaiah 50:6, 53:2-11
 - 4. Mentioned after the fact by Peter -Ac 2:22, 23

II. HE LAID IT DOWN WILLINGLY - Jn 15:13

A. TO SET MAN FREE FROM THE LAW

- 1. He fulfilled the law -Mt 5:17, 18
- 2. He gave us something greater
- a. Old law physical worship
- b. New law spiritual worship
- 3. No one could keep the law perfectly
 - a. All sin is lawlessness 1Jn 3:4
 - b. Law brings a curse, but Jesus redeems us Ga 3:10-14

B. TO SET MAN FREE FROM SIN

- 1. One sin makes one a slave unto it -Jn 8:34; Ro 6:16
 - a. Separates man from God -Is 59:2
 - b. Leads to death Ro 6:23; Ja 1:15
- 2. Christ came into the world to save sinners -1Ti 1:15
 - a. Blood of Jesus can cleanse any sin
 - b. God waits for man to repent -Lk 15:20; 2Pe 3:9
- 3. Grace abounds more than sin Ro 5:20
 - a. This is not a license to sin -Ro 6:1, 2
 - b. We are not to let sin reign in our bodies -Ro 6:12

Conclusion:

- 1. Our greatest blessing in life is Jesus...
 - a. His great love for us
 - b. His great sacrifice made on our behalf
- 2. The ultimate reason Jesus died upon the cross...
 - "...that where I am, there you may be also." Jn 14:3
