I. OBEDIENCE TO THE GOSPEL

A. ACKNOWLEDGE SIN

- 1. We have all sinned -Ro 3:23, 1Jn 1:8-10
- 2. Sin separates us from God -Is 59:1, 2
- 3. Wages of sin is death -Ro 6:23

B. KNOW THE SAVIOR

- 1. Jesus came to seek and save -Lk 19:10
- 2. He gave His life a ransom for many -Mt 20:28
- 3. Through His name only can we be saved -Ac 4:12

C. FOLLOW HIS WILL

- 1. One will not enter heaven apart from obedience -Mt 7:21-23; Jn 14:15
- 2. Steps of salvation:
 - a. Hear the message -Ro 10:
 - b. Believe in Jesus -Jn 8:24
 - c. Repent of our sins -Lk 13:3, 5
 - d. Confess Jesus before men -Lk 12:8, 9
 - e. Be baptized into Christ -Mk 16:16; Ac 2:38
 - f. Faithful living -Re 2:10; Co 1:19-23

II. GUARD AGAINST SIN

A. KNOW OUR ADVERSARY THE DEVIL

- 1. He is like a roaring lion -1Pe 5:8
- 2. He transforms into an angel of light -2Co 11:14
- 3. We are not ignorant of his devices -2Co 2:11

B. KNOW OUR COUNTER MEASURES

- 1. Have a predetermined mindset -Ez 7:10
- 2. Fill our heart with God's word -Co 3:16
- 3. Pray regularly -1Th 4:16
- 4. Fellowship -He 10:25, 26

III. ABOUND IN THE WORK OF THE LORD -1Co 15:58

A. THE WORK OF THE LORD

- 1. The physical needs of others -Ja 2:14-ff; 1Jn 3:16, 17
- 2. The emotional needs of others (sick/prison) Mt 25:
- 3. The spiritual needs of others Ep 3:10; Mt 28:18-20

B. THE RESULTS

- 1. Less opportunity for sin
- 2. Increased focus on the goal ahead
