Lesson #11 -The World's Hatred Scripture Reading: John 15:18-20

Introduction:

- 1. Sometimes the truth is not easy to hear -Ga 4:16
- 2. During times when the world is against us, there are somethings we should remember...

I. JESUS WAS HATED FIRST -Jn 15:18-20

- A. HIS LIFE AS THREATENED OFTEN
 - 1. His birth -Mt 2:1-18
 - 2. His home town of Nazareth -Lk 4:16-30
 - 3. The Jews wanted to stone Him -Jn 8:58; 10:31-39
 - 4. The chief priest and Pharisees plotted to kill Jesus -Jn 11:45-57
 - 5. He was delivered over the Pilate out of envy -Mt 27:18

B. HE WAS HATED WHEN DOING GOOD

- 1. Healing the paralyzed man -Mk 2:1-11
- 2. Healings on the Sabbath -Mt 12:9-14
- 3. Casting out demons -Mt 12:22-ff

II. JESUS CAME FROM THE FATHER

A. HIS WORDS TESTIFIED OF HIM

- 1. The crowd's reaction after the Sermon on the Mount -Mt 7:28, 29
- 2. After questioning -Mt 22:33, 46
- 3. The exclamation -Jn 7:46

B. HIS WORKS TESTIFIED OF HIM

- 1. Healing the blind man -Jn 9:32
- 2. Multiple healings -Lk 8:18-23
- 3. Raising of Lazarus -Jn 11:1-ff

III. JESUS HAS GIVEN US A MESSAGE TO DELIVER

- A. BEAR WITNESS OF JESUS
 - 1. The apostles would report all they had seen and heard -Ac 4:19, 20
 - 2. We are to shine the light of the gospel -2Co 4:6, 7

B. REACTION FROM THE WORLD

- 1. The New Testament
 - a. The people would persecute the apostles -Ac 5:40-42
 - b. Saul of Tarsus killed Steven -Ac 7:54-60
 - c. James dies by the sword of Herod -Ac 12:2

- 2. The church today
 - a. There are many that will hear the word of God with gladness (ie. The "in season" -2Ti 4:2)
 - b. There are, however, many who will love the world more than the word of truth (2Th 2:10-12)
