Introduction:

- 1. Younger siblings often learn from the mistakes of the older siblings.
- 2. We must learn from the example of the Israelites.
- 3. From their example, we learn about...

I. FAITH

A. THEIR LACK OF FAITH

- 1. Their lack of faith was on display -Ex 16:1-7
- 2. They have made a history of little faith
 - a. When Moses first came -Ex 5:20, 21
 - b. Before the Red Sea Crossing -Ex 14:10-12
 - c. Need for food -Ex 16:1-3

B. GOD IS WITH US TODAY

- 1. He never leaves us nor forsakes us -Mt 28:20; He 13:5
- 2. He is with us during times of...
 - a. Adversity -2Co 1:3-ff
 - b. Temptation -1Co 10:13
 - c. Sin -1Jn 2:1, 2; 2Ti 2:5; He 4:14-16

II. ANXIETY

- A. LEGITIMATE NEEDS (As opposed to wants)
 - 1. In our text, they needed water
 - 2. Man needs food, clothing, and shelter today.

B. WE HAVE BEEN TAUGHT NOT TO WORRY

- 1. Sermon on the Mount -Mt 6:25-33
- 2. Jesus taught by example:
 - a. During His time of temptation -Mt 4:2-4
 - b. When the disciples forgot to bring bread -Mk 8:13-21
- 3. Remember the observance of David -Ps 37:25

III. THANKFULNESS

A. CREATES FAITH

- 1. Thankfulness creates faith by getting us to look back
- 2. Israel should have done this (ie. The plagues upon Egypt, the Red Sea Crossing, the manna from heaven)
- 3. We do this by remembering all God has done for us (ie. The cross and the salvation that is only found in Christ.)

B. DESTROYS ANXIETY

- 1. Thankfulness does this by getting us to look ahead through a different lens.
- 2. David had no anxiety when it came to Goliath -1Sa 17:34-37
- 3. Jesus had no anxiety at all
 - a. He expressed thankfulness before feeding the 5,000 -Jn 6:11
 - b. He expressed thankfulness before raising Lazarus -Jn 11:41

Conclusion:

- 1. We should never wonder if the Lord is among us or not!
- 2. When we remember all that God has done for us and the promises He has made, we will know assuredly that the Lord is among us.
