Introduction:

- 1. Some are using a "New Hermeneutic" to introduce unauthorized practices into worship.
 - The "New Hermeneutic" focuses more on relationship between man and God
 - It undermines the necessity of keeping the commands of God
- 2. Loving God and being obedient unto Him are not mutually exclusive of one another.
- 3. How can we be certain we are right with God?
- 4. There are some things to understand to be right with God...

I. HERMENEUTIC STRUCTURE

A. THREE THINGS TO FOLLOW

- 1. Command -Mt 28:18-20
- 2. Example -Ac 20:7
- 3. Necessary inference -Mk 16:16
 - a. We know infant baptism is not permitted
 - b. A candidate for baptism must believe first.

B. CONTEXT

- 1. Who is speaking? -Job 2:9
- 2. The audience -e.g. Only Noah was told to build an ark
- 3. The times/culture

C. FIGURES OF SPEECH

- 1. Hyperbole -Mt 5:29, 30
- 2. Metonymy -1Co 11:25 (The cup)

II. GOD EXPECTS TO BE OBEYED

A. NOAH

- 1. He found grace in the eyes of God -Ge 6:8
- 2. He fully obeyed the Lord -Ge 6:22

B. UZZA -1Ch. 13:9-12

- 1. He reached out to hold the ark; God struck him dead.
- 2. No one was permitted to touch the holy things -Nu 4:15

III. OBEDIENCE IN THE BASIS OF GODLY LIVING

- A. OBEDIENCE IS HOW WE SHOW LOVE TO GOD
 - 1. God set life and death before His people -De 30:19, 20
 - 2. His desire is for man to choose life -Ez 18:30-32

B. OBEDIENCE IS HOW WE HONOR CHRIST

- 1. We are to hear and do His word -Mt 7:24-29
- 2. We are blessed if we know and do -Jn 13:17
- 3. If we love Christ, we will keep His commandments -Jn 14:15

Conclusion:

- 1. The church is the ground and pillar of the truth -1Ti 3:15.
- 2. Therefore, we must continue to stand for what is right -Jude 3
- 3. When we continue in these things, we are the church bought by Christ!
